Internship Objectives

The internships offered by ARCAJEF/TEGZAGON aim to provide international students with practical and academic experience in the fields of community development, governance, vocational training, and institutional communication

Areas of Intervention

ARCAJEF/TEGZAGON's activities include, among others:

- Vocational training and capacity building (tailoring, plumbing, metal fabrication, electricity, mechanics, metal carpentry, aluminum carpentry, masonry, tiling, livestock farming, etc.) and life skills
- Socio-economic support to promote professional integration
- Implementation of projects benefiting vulnerable communities, including internally displaced persons and disadvantaged girls
- Strategic partnerships to increase local impact

Candidate Qualifications and Profile

Applicants must meet at least one of the following criteria:

- Be enrolled in or have completed a graduate-level program or higher;
- Be in the final year of an undergraduate degree program or hold at least a bachelor's degree (or equivalent).

Note: No prior professional experience is required. However, applicants must submit a short concept note describing the objectives of the internship and their expectations.
